Thank you for your interest in being a volunteer for the Kenton County School District. As per KRS 17.160, the information provided on this form will be processed through the databanks of the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the Kentucky State Police. Please note the following disqualifiers: sex-related offense convictions; convictions against minors, felony offense convictions against persons or property, including felony drug convictions, alcohol violation convictions within two years from the date of the check and no more than two such offense convictions total within seven years from date of check; violence, threat-related or civil disturbance related misdemeanor convictions within seven years from date of check including assault, terroristic threatening, menacing, harassment, violations of EPO/DVO, stalking, resisting arrest, disorderly conduct, contempt of court and similar offenses; misdemeanor drug-related offense convictions within seven years from date of check; deadly weapon-related offense convictions; a pattern of irresponsible behavior based upon the background check.
